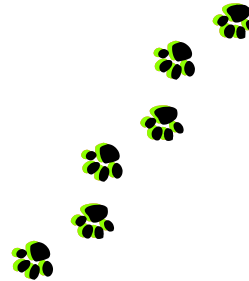




PIONEER HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST FOR 2016 – 2017
